## City of Bunnell Regulations for Mobile Food Trucks operating within City limits

- (1) Food trucks are limited to a self-contained truck or trailer.
- (2) Location: Food trucks may be located only on privately-owned commercial or industrial zoned property with written permission from the property owner.
  - a. Food Trucks shall be located no less than 200 feet from any residentially-zoned property.
  - b. Food trucks shall be located no less than 200 feet from the main entrance of any other eating establishment (including another food truck), unless the owner of such establishment provides the food truck owner with a written letter of no objection, a copy of which must be presented to the City at the time of application.
- (3) Signage and Hours: Signage is limited to those signs that are painted on or attached to the vehicle. Hours of operation are limited to 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- (4) Parking of Food Truck: Food trucks shall only occupy and utilize excess on-site parking spaces (those above and beyond minimum parking requirements for existing uses). Sketch showing were the food truck will be parked on the property must be presented to the City at the time of application.
- (5) Licenses and Permits. All required state and local permits and business licenses shall be obtained, held, maintained and displayed at all times.
- (6) Operations: Food truck vehicles shall be maintained in a clean and orderly manner; litter and debris shall be removed nightly.
  - a. A lidded trash can shall be provided on-site for customer use; no unscreened plastic bags or loose objects shall be allowed.
  - b. The operator shall remove waste/trash at the end of each day or as needed to maintain the health and safety of the public.

- c. Liquid waste or grease shall be disposed of at an approved location and not placed in such places as sewer system, storm drains or onto any sidewalk, street or other public space.
- (7) Employee Restroom: An agreement with the property owner for use of on-site facilities or a nearby property owner (within 400 feet) to provide bathroom facilities for food truck workers is required.

By signing this application, I hereby certify that I will comply with the City of Bunnell Regulations for Mobile Food Trucks (above).

If at any point in time, I fail to comply with these standards, I understand that my Permit may be temporarily or permanently revoked and I may be denied from receiving a Mobile Food Truck Permit in the future by the City of Bunnell.
