**Bunnell To Modify How Face-To-Face
Business is done at City Hall**

Bunnell, FL (March 17, 2020) – The City of Bunnell is open and providing services to its citizens and stakeholders; however, due to the need to practice social distancing, the City is modifying how direct business will be conducted with City staff.

Effective March 18, 2020, the City is suspending face-to-face contact with City staff. Any utility bill payments can be done by mail, phone, on-line or by placing them in the drop box located at City Hall. Any other documents that need to be turned into the City can be sent by fax, e-mail or dropped off in a box located in the City Hall lobby.

City staff are at work during normal business hours- Monday through Friday 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM- and will be available by phone and e-mail to answer questions citizens and stakeholders need answered.
