Bunnell State of the City Postponed

Bunnell, **FL (April 14, 2020)** – At the April 13, 2020 City Commission meeting, the Bunnell City Commission adopted Emergency Resolution 2020-07 which rescheduled the Charter required Mayor's Annual State of the City. This address is normally given during the second Commission Meeting in April which would have been April 27, 2020.

Given the necessity to protect the lives of its citizens and the current Executive Orders from the Governor and the declared Local State of Emergency, it was determined by the City this was a necessary action. The State of the City will be rescheduled and notice of that date will be provided.

All residents and businesses are urged to follow Florida Department of Health and CDC guidance, to include:

- Avoiding close contact with people who are sick;
- Staying home when you are sick and avoiding contact with persons in poor health;
- Avoiding touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands;
- Covering your cough or sneezing into a tissue, then disposing of the tissue;
- Washing your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing;
- If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty; and
- Cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
