Position: Utilities Maintenance Tech III

The City Commission desires candidates who are visionary, innovative and team oriented in their approach, and able to employ a style that engenders mutual trust and openness with community Partners and Stake holders.

Position incumbents are engaged in the construction, operation, and maintenance of water distribution, and/or wastewater collection facilities and systems. Positions allocated to this classification work under general supervision and are given general work requirements.

Duties:

- Performs work in the maintenance and repair of water and/or wastewater facilities and systems by expertly operating the heaviest and/or most complex specialized equipment such as excavators, rubber tire backhoes, TV cameras, etc.
- Consults with supervisor and offers suggestions for effective and efficient completion of jobs in which the specialized equipment is used
- Cuts slopes and new grades in accordance with measurements and specifications.
- Serves as field instructor for lower-level technicians.
- Expertly operates various water and/or wastewater equipment such as tapping machines, pipe saws, rodding equipment, high pressure jetting and vac-trucks, televising, pipe grouting, and other equipment.
- Responds to emergency maintenance calls.
- Any other duties assigned

Skills/Qualifications:

- Knowledge of occupational hazards and accident prevention methods in assigned area of responsibility.
- Ability to solve problems by identifying and resolving problems in a timely manner; gather and analyzes information skillfully; develops alternative solutions; works well in group problem solving situations/ uses reason even when dealing with emotional topics.
- Writes clearly and informatively; presents numerical data effectively; able to read and interpret written information.
- Ability to bend, stoop, climb, lift 60lbs, and work in adverse weather situations.

Educational Requirements:

- High School or GED equivalency or higher post-secondary degree
- 24 months experience as Utility Maintenance Tech II or equivalent position.

Professional Licenses:

- Valid Florida Driver's License
- Must Possess FDOT CDL B
- Must possess and maintain valid FWPCOA Collections Certificate and/or FDEP Distribution License.
